One of the most impactful ways you can support your child's reading development is by engaging in regular reading activities at home.

The power of Listening to your child read out loud

When you listen to your child read, you offer invaluable support. This includes:

- **Building Confidence**: Your attentive listening and encouragement help build your child's confidence in their reading abilities.
- **Providing immediate feedback**: You can provide gentle corrections and guidance, helping them to improve their pronunciation and comprehension on the spot.
- **Understanding Pace and Expression**: By listening, you can help your child learn to read with proper pace and expression, which are key components of fluency.

The benefits of reading to your child

Reading to your child, regardless of their age, also offers significant benefits:

- **Exposure to Rich Language**: It introduces them to a richer vocabulary and more complex sentence structures than they might encounter in their own reading.
- **Modeling Fluent Reading**: You demonstrate fluent reading, showcasing the rhythm, tone, and emotion that bring stories to life.
- **Bonding Time**: Reading together strengthens your bond with your child, making reading a pleasurable and cherished activity.

Tips for Reading Together

- **Set a Routine**: Establish a regular reading time each day. It can be a part of your bedtime routine or a quiet moment after school.
- **Be Enthusiastic**: Show enthusiasm and interest in the stories. Your excitement can be contagious!
- **Discuss the Story**: Ask questions about the story to engage your child and enhance comprehension. Discussing the plot, characters, and their motivations makes the reading experience interactive and educational.


Each day your child reads at home, don't forget to sign them off in their communication book to earn points for their house team!

Year 6-7 Transition, 2025


















DFS is scheduled to visit during:
