Each class will be engaging in a range of technology-focused activities, including coding, artificial intelligence and problem solving. Our primary aim is to provide opportunities for students to demonstrate their tech skills and creative thinking in fun and meaningful ways.

It has been an incredible week filled with laughter, learning, and technological exploration. **Tech Week** has allowed our students to expand their understanding of the digital world. 


