As families register for tickets the school will receive notification. There is no need to print or download tickets as the school will receive confirmation of your order and your name will be checked off on entry to the Hall at the main entrance on the night.

Families are able to order a <u>maximum of three tickets per family</u> at no cost. If you know you will <u>not</u> require your allocation of 3 family tickets, please advise the front office ASAP and we will allocate these tickets the general public.

On Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> of December families must have ordered their 3 family tickets; after this date any remaining tickets will be made available to the general public – (for grandparents etc) so please make sure you log on and order your family tickets asap to guarantee your family seats.

Tickets will **not** be available after 3.30pm on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> December, 2024.


# Year 1 Mrs Bruce & Mrs Kluske
















# Year 1 Mrs Bruce & Mrs Kluske
